When you join as a Team Captain, you become an ambassador for ICS and by inviting people to know more about ICS, you make a profound difference in the lives of people in our community struggling to survive.

The ICS Putt Putt Tournament is a Peer-to-Peer fundraising event.

Instead of paying a large fee for your team to participate, each member of your team is encouraged to fundraise by asking their friends, family, coworkers and colleagues to give.

Each team will receive a link, unique to their team, that they can share and start fundraising for people experiencing hunger and homelessness.

So as Team Captain, your first step is to set-up your team page!

CREATE YOUR TEAM FUNDRAISING PAGE – Team Captain

Go to the ICS Putt Putt page: <https://bit.ly/puttputt2026>

- *Step 1: Click on the button that says **Start a Team***
~ This will direct you to the main putt putt page.
- *Step 2: Click Fundraising button to create your team.*
- *Step 3: Create a team name, choose a goal (recommended minimum \$1,000).*
~ Enter name, email and photo. Click button "Create Team"
- *Step 4: Edit Campaign: Tell your story about why ICS matters to you and your community in the description box.*
~ Feel free to use the information already provided for you and your Personal Story - or get creative and make the page unique to you!
- *Step 5: SAVE your fundraising page.*
- *Step 6: Go to your email, you should receive an email from Immanuel Community Services – Zeffy. Be sure to check under promotions and other tabs if you don't see it.*
~ There is a link to your campaign page and a link to set up a profile. This will allow you to go back into your page, make changes and update.
- *Step 7: Start recruiting team members (see below).*
- *Step 8: Start sharing the link with your networks and fundraise for ICS!*

RECRUIT TEAM MEMBERS

- Reach out to your family, friends, neighbors and/or coworkers, inviting them to join your Putt Putt team and make a difference in the lives of those who are experiencing hunger, homelessness and addiction.
 - ~ Your team size caps at 6 members (including yourself).
 - ~ If you have more than 6 members, you can split into two teams
- Send each team member the link **to your team's unique fundraising page**.
 - ~ They will use this link to send out to their networks to fundraise for the team.
 - ~ They also have the option of creating their own profile on the team.
- As Team Captain, you can see options to manage your team when you are logged in at the top of your fundraising page.
 - ~ You can click on "EDIT CAMPAIGN" to update the images and contents of your fundraising page.

LET THE FUNDRAISING BEGIN! –

Remember this IS a competition and the Grand Prize goes to the team that raises the most funds!!

- Please see the *Fundraising Guide* with info and tips to help make your fundraising experience easy breezy!
- Send out the link to your team's fundraising page to everyone you would like to invite to give. You can do this via email, text, social media, etc.
- Donors can also send checks.
 - ~ Checks should be made out to "Immanuel Community Services" or "ICS".
 - Mailing address: 1215 Thomas St., Seattle, WA 98109.
 - ~ Team name should be written in the memo field so we can credit your team!
 - ~ Checks must be received by **Friday, 17 July**, to be included in team totals.

PREPARING YOUR TEAM

- Keep in touch with your team over the next few weeks.
 - ~ See how their fundraising is going, answer any questions, plan team costumes, etc.
 - ~ Remind them the day before; emails will be sent a few days before the event with directions and additional information.
